GROWING OUR OWN FISH FOR THE FUTURE

VRFish, the peak body representing Victorian recreational fishers, welcomes the commitment to build a new purpose-built native fish hatchery in Victorian by a re-elected Labor Government.

VRFish Chairman, Mr. Rob Loats said, "VRFish have been advocating for a new native fish hatchery. We need to be growing our own fish to secure Victoria's fishing future."

A re-elected Labor will commit \$7 million to build a new native fish hatchery in Shepparton to breed warm water native species such as Murray cod and golden perch.

Recreational fishing in Victoria is booming with over 6-million fish stocked in the past year, however, close to 4-million were purchased from interstate suppliers.

"Our native freshwater fisheries are growing in popularity. A new hatchery is necessary to keep up with demand and ensure we can continue to boost Victorian native fish stocks."

A purpose-built hatchery will better suit the needs of warm water native fish than the only Victorian Government run hatchery, $\operatorname{Snob}'s$ Creek Hatchery, which was established to breed cooler water salmonids.

"We look forward to seeing the Liberal-National's plan to boost our Victorian native fish stocks."

VRFish will continue to advocate for the future of recreational fishing in Victoria. This once again demonstrates the value of having a strong and independent recreational fishing peak body.
